

In telling the fictitious story of Barnabas Sackett coming on a ship from England to America in the 1600s, Louis L'Amour describes Sackett's shipmates like this: "They were rascals, no question of that, and a dirty, poisonous lot, enough to kill the fish for miles if dumped into the water" (Sackett's Land, Bantam Books [1974], pg. 71).

In Ephesus, some false teachers had fallen into the waters of the churches in that city (and region), and they were having a poisoning and potentially deadly effect. This is why Paul immediately addressed Timothy, "As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons

not to teach any different doctrine, nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith" (1 Tim 1:3-4).

Who were these false teachers? They are called "certain persons" (ESV; "some men," NASB) in verses 3 and 6. We aren't told their exact identity. They may have been former elders in the church because, several years

Paul's appeal to his assistant will help us to think about dealing with false teaching in our churches, whether we are in the "infestation" stage or not. Let's start by considering three questions about the false teachers. previously, Paul told the Ephesians elders, "From among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them" (Acts 20:30). If this was now the situation, the urgency to deal with

these men would have been heightened because people might have given them the benefit of the doubt.


What did they teach? Paul calls it a "different doctrine" (1 Tim 1:3). The same phrase is found in chapter 6 and provides further explanation: "If anyone teaches a different doctrine and does not agree with the sound words of our Lord Jesus Christ and the teaching that accords with godliness..." (v. 3) These men contradicted the words of Jesus, and consequently did not produce holy people.

In chapter 4, Paul called their teaching a "depart[ure] from the faith" and demonic (v. 1), and highlighted

#### • • The Mountain Top and The Day-To-Day • •

On a flight recently, I overheard a woman describing the town she was from. She said it is tucked away in a little corner of the Northeast. I could hear the warmth for her home in her voice as she was speaking. She talked about how the trees were not huge, but there were very beautiful, forested areas. What struck me the most was when she said that the nature there was not the "wow" that you might see in many other areas of the country, but it was quietly beautiful. I knew exactly what she meant.

I have had the privilege of seeing some amazing sights in our country. I have seen the giant stone mountains of Yosemite. I have been in the Rocky Mountains in Colorado and made my way to the top of Pike's Peak. I have lived in California my whole life and have stood where the land and the ocean meet many times. I have gazed up at the giant redwood trees in the coastal forests.

However, I too live in a place of quiet beauty. The oak trees outside my windows don't make a flashy show of color in the Fall, but they subtly change throughout the year in a steady way. The little bluebirds may not be as brightly colored as some of their feathered friends, but they too are



consistently busy adding cheer to the world just outside.

There is a difference in how we experience these two types of nature. The "wow" type can inspire awe in us for our Creator. I know when I saw the mountains in Yosemite, it really sunk in just how big our God must be. These types of experiences make me think of our "mountain top" times with God, the spiritual highs. The other, quieter type of nature makes me think of our day-to-day lives or the times when we need to "soak" with God, the times when we just need to lean on our Heavenly Father.

Even Jesus, when He was here on Earth, had these two different types of experiences. He had the moment after Baptism when the Heavens opened up and His Father blessed Him. He went up to the Mount of Transfiguration. Then He also experienced being alone and fasting for 40 days and being tested

by Satan. He spent many quiet hours alone praying with God.

We need both of these types of experiences in our spiritual walk. The mountain top times can give us vision, excitement and spur us on, but just like most of us can't live at Yosemite, we also cannot maintain that type of spiritual high constantly. We are designed to come back down to the quieter, steadier places and live outsometimes struggle out—those "wow" moments of the mountains.

"Come, let us sing for joy to the LORD; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song. For the LORD is the great God, the great King above all gods. In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land." Psalm 95:1-5

#### Did You Know?

- The exact crossing place of the Red Sea is specific as "directly opposite Baal Zephon" (Exodus 14:2) The Hebrew for "Red Sea" is the "Sea of Reeds." As reeds do not grow in salt water, the crossing is unlikely to have been in the north end of the Gulf of Suez. An Egyptian papyrus has placed Baal Zephon at the southern end of Lake Menzaleh.
- We refer to the summary of God's law of Exodus 19:2-17 as the "Ten Commandments." Exodus 20:1 says, "God spake all these words." The Ten Commandments literally mean the "Ten Words," The are also know by the Greek term "Decalogue," which means "Ten Words,"
- For the Israelites, the tabernacle was God's royal tent. The Ten Commandments were placed inside the ark of the covenant. On top of the ark were two golden cherubim. Among the treasures found in King Tutankhaun's Egyptian tomb, are two winged guardians made to shield sacred places.
- Rahab provided secret shelter for the spies who entered Jericho. Josephus says that Rahab was an innkeeper. Archeological evidence shows that houses were built into the walls of Jericho. Late Bronze Age fortifications at Jericho reveal casement (hollow) walls, which may have provided Rahab with her rooms.







#### **A MAN NAMED GAIUS**



(Editor's note: This is part one of a series of articles on the book of 2 John by Pastor Dave Peterson of Loma Rica Baptist Church)

#### 2 John 1-2

- 1 The Elder: To my dear friend Gaius: I love you in the truth.
- 2 Dear friend, I pray that you may prosper in every way and be in good health physically just as you are spiritually.

While written to Gaius, this letter, by the sovereignty of God, has made its way into the Holy Scriptures, so while it may seem as if we are reading someone else's mail – the truth is that this letter is for you and I as well.

# 1. The Elder: To my dear friend Gaius: I love you in the truth.

So first, we know that Gaius was an elder, a leader, quite possibly the pastor of a church, and that he was a dear friend of John the Apostle – and that this friendship goes deep, because they have a love that is rooted in the truth.

Not rooted in "a" truth – but "THE" truth – the truth of the gospel, the truth

of a shared faith, the truth of salvation, the truth of Jesus. This is a truth that unites even today. We may disagree on many minor things, but the major thing – Jesus – is what unites us in love.

#### 2. Dear friend, I pray that you may prosper in every way and be in good health physically just as you are spiritually.

While the prayer that John prays is for physical well-being, and well-being in every way – that would include financial, employment, family, resources, investments - the foundation, the focus of the prayer is the spiritual prosperity of Gaius.

He is praying that as Gaius soul is prospering, as His walk with Christ is growing, as His relationship with Christ is deepening, He wants to see Gaius blessed in these other ways to the same degree that He is growing spiritually.

Is that a great prayer, or what?!?! Or is it? What if I prayed for you in the same way? Or if you prayed for me in the same way? What if right now, we were

#### Follow the Trail of Money and Anguish

One of the most pressing issues before the pro-life movement is how to stop chemical abortion. It is called mifepristone, marketed under the name of Mifeprex, the first pill in the twodrug abortion protocol.

It is an outright lie by extreme abortion advocates that "chemical abortion is safer than Tylenol." Our video interview with Elizabeth Gillette defies this falsehood. In addition to the severe pain and hemorrhaging Elizabeth experienced, as she held the child she passed, this young woman faced the horrific, undeniable reality that she killed her baby. This tragic awareness came with a whole other level of serious side effects.

The aftermath of chemical abortion for Elizabeth included, in her words, an "overwhelming guilt I couldn't put away." She also suffered from nightmares, anorexia, and a diagnosis of acute post-traumatic stress disorder. There is no credible study that can associate similar levels of concern with Tylenol.

Who and what is behind the behemoth effort to inflict this chemical coat hanger on millions of unsuspecting women? Let's look at the extreme pro-abortion



activists and those who fund their effort to push these deadly pills.

The most prominent pro-abortion groups pushing chemical abortion are the Center for Reproductive Rights, Whole Woman's Health, Guttmacher Institute, National Health Law Program, and Physicians for Reproductive Health. Besides ideology, these organizations have several things in common, Their donors. Much of their funding comes from left-leaning foundations that give heavily to causes advocating abortion on demand until birth. Let's look at each group and the foundations that give to them.

The Center for Reproductive Rights (CRR) describes itself as "a global human rights organization of lawyers and advocates who ensure" the

accessibility of abortion. According to CRR's most recent annual report, they document gifts between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022. The top donors include Laura and John Arnold, who appear to have personally given over \$1,000,000 to CRR rather than through their foundation. In addition, the Ford Foundation and the William and Flora Hewlett Foundation have given enormous sums. While founded by Henry Ford and his son, Edsel, it is important to note that the Ford Foundation is not connected to Ford Motor Company.

The Ford Foundation gave CRR \$500,000 in 2022 which does not include the collective \$15,025,000 that it has given to CRR since 2007. That sum also includes a \$7,500,000

Social Bond in October 2020. The William and Flora Hewlett Foundation (William Hewlett is a cofounder of Hewlett-Packard) has given CRR a total of \$17,232,500 since 2001 with multiple grants over \$2,000,000. Hewlett-Packard's other founder, David and Lucile Packard Foundation. gave CRR \$500,000 in 2022 and a collective \$3,037,915. Although it is unclear exactly how much was given, Bloomberg Philanthropies - founded in 2006 by Michael Bloomberg - was also a \$1,000,000-plus donor to CRR. It should surprise no one that George Soros is also a large donor. His Open Society Foundation has given a total of \$365,000 in two grants, both in 2016.

Whole Woman's Health (WWH), a chain of abortion facilities, was founded in 2003 by Amy Hagstrom Miller. While this group is smaller, it has received the attention of the large foundations. The William and Flora Hewlett Foundation has given WWH a total of \$1,000,000 in grants since 2016.

Guttmacher Institute (GI) was initially founded as the research arm of Planned Parenthood. GI is now an independent

#### **MENTAL HEALTH MINUTE**

#### Pastors and Mental Health: We Need to Normalize this Conversation

Mental health affects a large majority of the population, and pastors are no exception.

What's more, mental health challenges can be one of the largest barriers standing in the way of pastors both serving well and finishing well. In light of Mental Health Awareness Month, churches have the opportunity to empower pastors to continue serving and advancing God's Kingdom by normalizing conversations about mental health.

As pastors, serving well requires having the strength to do so. The weight of a pastor's call to lead both his congregation and his family is rewarding but can be exhausting without adequate support from multiple different sources, including strong staff, close friends and time off. These days, churches can also lighten the load by empowering pastors to seek professional help. This includes answering the call of 64% of pastors who need support in order to consistently practice Sabbath rest.

Since 2020, mental health claims by pastors that GuideStone® serves have gone up by 40%. This trend is



a promising sign that more pastors feel validated to access this important resource in their benefits package. And we are hopeful that continued access to mental health services will play a strong role in reducing burnout and turnover in the churches we serve.

Ministry fatigue is real, and it can stop some pastors in their tracks. I know this first-hand because it happened to me 15 years ago in the middle of my 20th year of pastoring churches. During that time, I was walking through a heavy fog of exhaustion and undiagnosed clinical depression that nearly caused me to walk away from serving my congregation.

Instead, I was able to seek help from a mental health professional and began attending monthly therapy sessions. By receiving this support, I was not only able to continue pastoring my church, but eventually doors would open to helping other pastors who needed the same help.

More pastors may be refreshed and feel supported if they, too, have access to the help they need. Our country now spends over \$200 billion annually on mental health care, providing increased resources for the 1 in 5 Americans who experience mental illnesses.

Pastors must know these resources

are available and — more importantly — feel comfortable accessing them. That's why it is essential to continue normalizing mental health services for ministers and remove barriers to access by extending insurance coverage for mental health care.

Severe burnout, at least the type I experienced, can be prevented, but not if the topic of mental health remains taboo in the Church. And not if pastors feel discouraged from seeking help in the midst of their darkest seasons. I speak from experience in saying that receiving mental health support can be the game changer pastors need to continue serving the Lord, their families, and congregants well.

Removing barriers to mental health access for pastors empowers them to finish their race well, both in their personal life and in their ministry. In doing so, we not only strengthen pastors' personal well-being but also protect the future of churches for years to come.

its emphasis on externals (v. 3). Fundamentally, they wanted to be "teachers of the law," and they taught it both confidently and ignorantly at the same time (1:7)! Specifically, they were infatuated with "myths" (presumably far-fetched stories derived from genealogies in the Old Testament) and "endless genealogies" (i.e., unending discussion about family trees). The gospel of grace was nowhere to be found.

What did their teaching produce? It led to "speculations" (1:4). The false teachers started with Scripture, but went beyond what it plainly says both in its original context and its connection to Jesus. The result was an obsession with "speculative theories" that became "vain discussion" (v. 6).

And it wasn't as if their teaching was "tolerable," like a person today who talks too often about the tricky details of Revelation but who, overall, really loves Jesus. No, the false teachers' devotion to the "deep things" of the law was damnable because it promoted "speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith" (v. 4, emphasis added). God's redemptive design is salvation by faith and for his people to live by faith. But the false teachers moved people away



out of that!

from that to a "different doctrine" producing "envy, dissension, slander, evil suspicions, and constant friction among people" (6:4b-5a). The gospel was stamped out as they majored not only on the minors, but the obscure! The consequences were devastating.

In dramatic contrast to the false teachers, Paul reminded Timothy, "The aim of our charge," the goal of apostolic preaching and teaching, "is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith" (1:5). The false teachers "swerv[ed] from these" (v. 6) and instead produced divisive hearts, guilty, confused consciences, and hypocrites (not "sincere faith"). Love won't ever flow

#### Three Lessons:

First, church leaders must "charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine." No church leader should like this responsibility, but they all should willingly engage when necessary.

Second, church leaders should

consider the fruit of their ministry. Are you seeing people grow in their love for the Lord and one another, or is something else produced by your ministry to them? Love will never flow out of an atmosphere of speculative theories and strife, but a culture of worshipping and listening to Jesus.

Third, believers must watch out for Bible teachers who major on the minors (or the obscure) to the neglect of the gospel and the "plain things." Saying something a tad strange is normally not a problem. But when weirdness becomes the norm and Christ is overshadowed, beware! And think about it: we will go our whole lives and never achieve a full understanding of Jesus and his teaching. Why would we ever want to stray from something, and SOMEONE, so magnificent?

I've had the privilege for many years to work out with Tim Keller.


Well, actually, Tim and I never met in person. But I've listened to countless of his "Gospel in Life" podcasts while training at the gym.

If you're like me, you probably have a rotation of trusted Christian teachers you use to increase your knowledge of God. Currently, I have four, with Keller leading the pack.

Like many of you, I was deeply grieved to learn about Tim being ushered into the presence of the Lord He has served so faithfully. It's no exaggeration to say our world is a bit darker now with one of God's brightest "lights in the world" (Phil. 2:15) being absent.

The online journal I use to document meaningful quotes and links to impactful articles and videos about Christianity is brimming over with Keller material, and for good reason. The man is a master of communication with brainpower that far exceeds my own in every direction, especially when it's aimed upward as his always is.

It's difficult for me to pluck out the top three things Keller has implanted in my soul about God, but I'm going to take a swing at it nonetheless.



# #1 Good religion, philosophy, and science all arrive at the same place

We've all heard the line "All truth is God's truth". If you've ever listened to or read Tim's books, you know he is a maestro with few equals when it comes to bringing together diverse and vast amounts of intellectual firepower to make his point.

Tugging at the thinking of the ancient Greek and contemporary philosophers while at the same time summoning the thoughts of leading scientists and theologians, Keller will lead you back to God, one way or the other, with every word that comes out of their mouths.

And when he does that, he shows you that right thinking – whether it's purely philosophical, scientific, or theological

– all end up at the same destination: right in the Creator's lap.

Our problem with that fact, and with God in general, isn't so much intellectual, Tim said – it's usually either pride or a too-good-to-be-true attitude. "Grace is insulting," says Keller, "One side says they don't need forgiveness whereas the other side says that's too easy."

# #2 It's OK (even good) to be real about your faith

I remember laughing out loud during one of Keller's messages about faith where he stated, "People think that faith is something others naturally possess like good looks, athletic ability, etc., and think I'll never have that. When they get into a situation that's bad, they think that faith is like your furnace and thermostat where your heat just automatically kicks on. WHOOSH."

Except that's rarely how faith works, he said. Most times, we're crippled by life's body blows and can barely speak the words, "I do believe; help my unbelief" (Mark 9:24).

How true.

Tim admitted his own struggles with understanding both the difficult sayings of Scripture and events that seemed to not make sense in life. And that, he said, is normal so we shouldn't be embarrassed to feel that way sometimes or experience guilt when we cry out like Habakkuk in anger to God.

#### #3 It's all about Jesus

# He does it in every message. Every. Single. One.

Just today, I listened to Tim's sermon "Abraham and the Torch." Keller, like always, masterfully worked through the Old Testament text of God making a covenant with Abraham.

He got to the part where the Scripture says, "When the sun had set and darkness had fallen, a smoking firepot with a blazing torch appeared and

to pray that prayer over everyone who reads this article, and instantly, your bank account would reflect where you are spiritually this morning?

Now at first, we might say, "Well, I'd be fine with that. I'm saved. I go to church."

Time for some brutal honesty. That is simply Christianity-lite. Diet Discipleship. Saved, and in church is not quite the same as sanctified, set apart, on fire, in the Word, praying Jericho walls tumbling down prayers, and being passionately devoted to the Lord.

Too many of God's children are living in spiritual poverty, neglecting time in the Word and prayer, and choosing to play with the world rather than devote time to growing in their relationship with the Lord.

This is why this passage is more about

the spiritual fitness of Gaius, than him prospering in "every way." Because according to this prayer, if Gaius is spiritually weak, spiritually flabby, spiritually anemic and spiritually out of shape, then the prayer to "prosper in every way" is not going to amount to much prosperity in any way.

The Apostle Paul echoes this idea of being spiritually fit when he wrote to Timothy in 2 Timothy 4:7-8, "...train yourself in godliness. For the training of the body has limited benefit, but godliness is beneficial in every way, since it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come."

So I pray that you too may be in good health, and to prosper in every way – but even more so, I pray that you might be spiritually healthy, strong in prayer, worship, and the study of the Word, living out your faith as you live out your life.

passed between the pieces. On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram" (Gen. 15:17-18).

Tim discussed how God Himself passed through the sacrifices Abraham had prepared to ratify the covenant in the deep darkness that had fallen. He then made a sharp right turn to the New Testament and read an account of the crucifixion of Jesus: "From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land" (Matt. 27:45).

In his typical undramatic style, Keller then joined the two accounts together to show how Jesus became our sacrifice in the darkness to sign, in His own blood, God's covenant with us. Had I ever made that connection before?

Never.


But that's what Tim does every single time – he makes a beeline at the end of each message to Jesus to show us that the Bible is, ultimately, all about Him.

And now he's with the One he has pointed us to for decades. Our loss. His gain.

Tim's cancer may have finally overcome his body, but the man himself is now where every oncologist is out of a job. When, by the grace of God, I get to where Keller is right now, he can count on me looking him up to thank him for being such a source of knowledge, help, and inspiration to me.

And if there are gyms in Heaven, who knows, maybe he and I can work out together in person. Now that would be something.

research nonprofit and is named in honor of the former president of Planned Parenthood, Alan Guttmacher. GI has received \$2,000,000 since 2019 from John and Laura Arnold's foundation, Arnold Ventures. GI has been given a total of \$5,325,000 from the David and Lucille Packard Foundation since 2018. Meanwhile, the William and Flora Hewlett Foundation has granted GI 27,002,700 since 2011. The Ford Foundation has doled out \$3,680,000 in total while the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation has given GI a total of \$19,494,409 since 1995. Lastly, Mackenzie Scott (former wife of Jeff Bezos) – through her foundation, Yield Giving – granted \$15,000,000 to GI in 2022. GI a total of \$19,494,409 since 1995.

The National Health Law Program (NHLP) was founded by Ruth and Milton Roemer in 1969 to help low-income individuals and families with healthcare and also with abortion. Arnold Ventures has given \$485,000 since 2020. The William and Flora Hewlett Foundation has donated two grants, totaling \$530,000. The David and Lucile Packard Foundation has given \$1,428,250 in grants since 2018. The Ford Foundation is the largest

collective donor to the NHLP, with \$3,534,750 given since 2007. Lastly, George Soros makes another appearance with the Open Society Foundations, giving \$1,000,000 in 2017.


Physicians for Reproductive Health (PRH) was founded in 1992 by a group of physicians in New York City with a mission of teaching others to effectively defend late-term abortion, advocate against pro-life pregnancy centers and promote illegal self-managed abortions. Arnold Ventures gave \$250,000 in a two-year grant from 2021 to 2023. The William and Flora Hewlett

Foundation granted the collective sum of \$4,220,500 to PRH. Lastly, the Ford Foundation granted \$450,000 in 2006 and \$600,000 in 2008.

This is just a sampling of the big money behind Big Abortion. Many of these donors are older foundations that were initially set up to do good in the world but have veered off their original, intended courses.

As Judge Matthew Kacsmaryk's ruling makes its way to the U.S. Supreme Court, we intend to shine a penetrating light on those inflicting such bodily harm and mental anguish on millions of women like Elizabeth.
